The urban furniture can be distinguished from each entrance to Axelborg so that they even invite outside users to playfully explore the circuit.



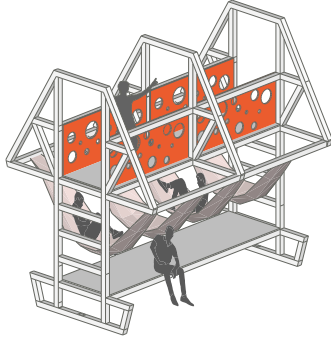
Urban furniture circuit

Hydroponic System

Personal interests such as family gardens can be developed in these modules as they can be shared among the entire community and thus generate greater interaction with others. For this reason, we advocate for the implementation of hydroponic gardens on part of the canopy of the urban furniture.



- 1 Pipe with nutrient enriched water
- 2 Aquaponic pipes

These systems are extremely efficient in water usage, requiring a lower percentage of water needed for cultivation, while also reducing the use of fertilizers.
